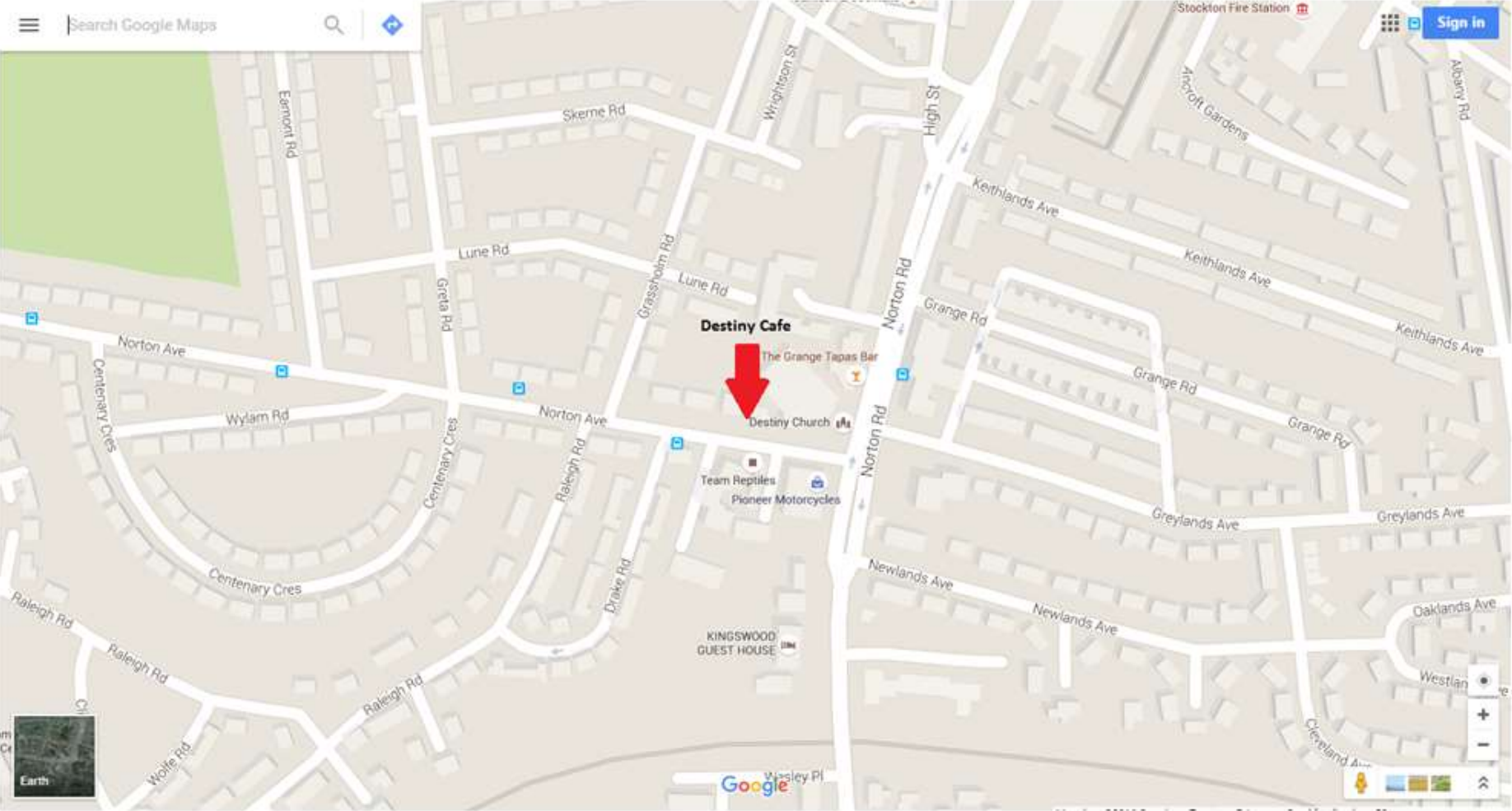
Billingham Central



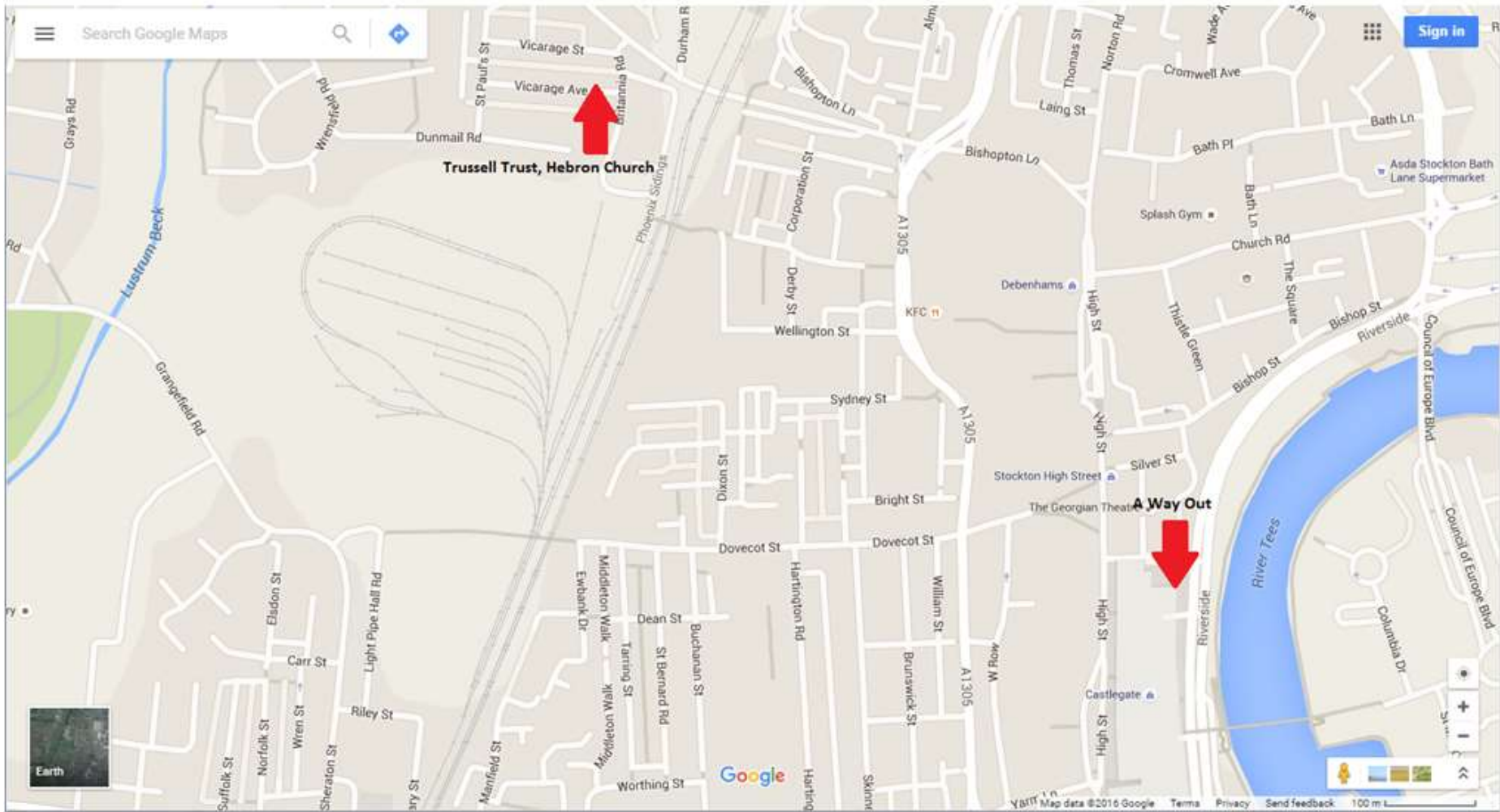

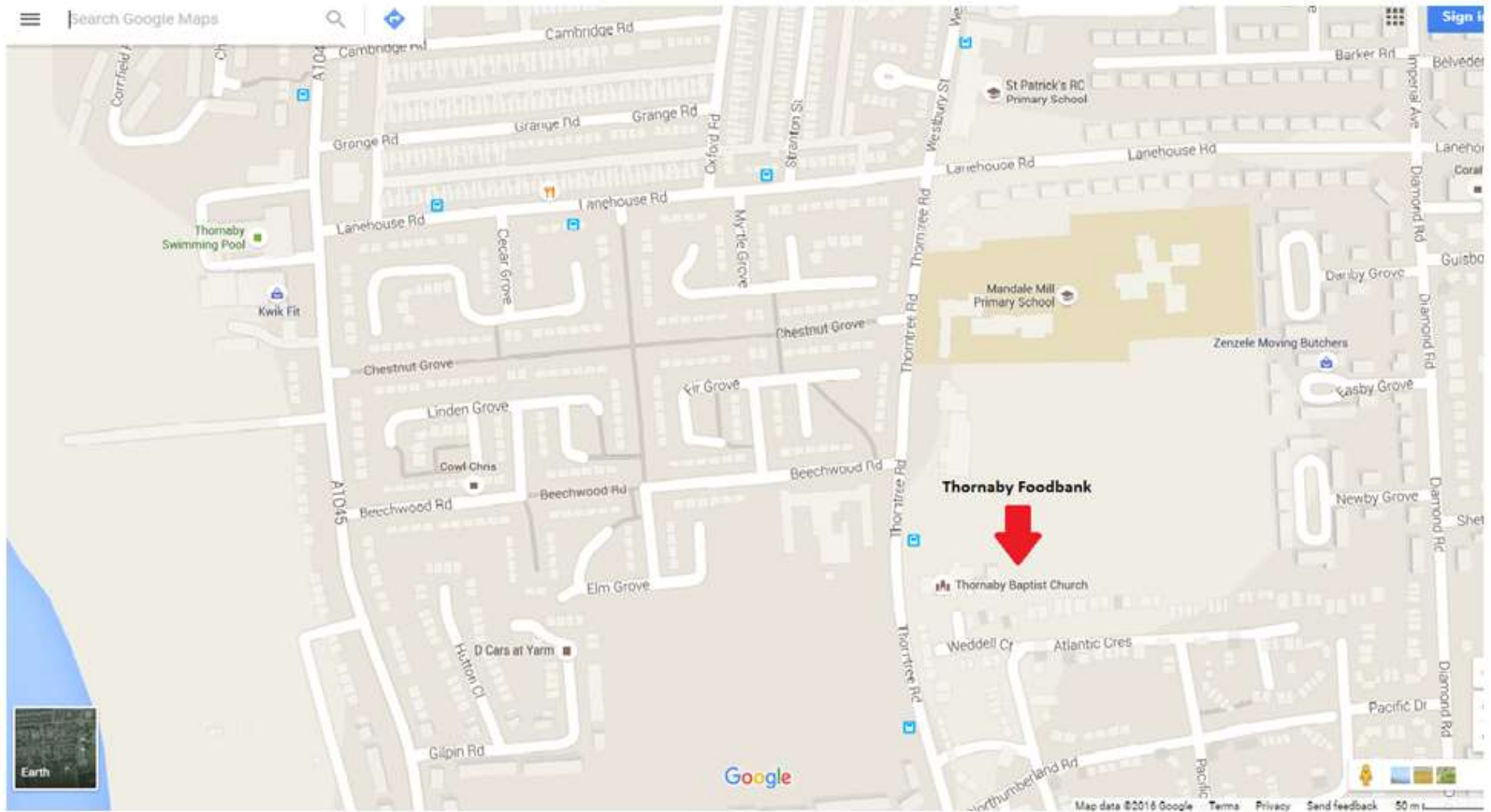

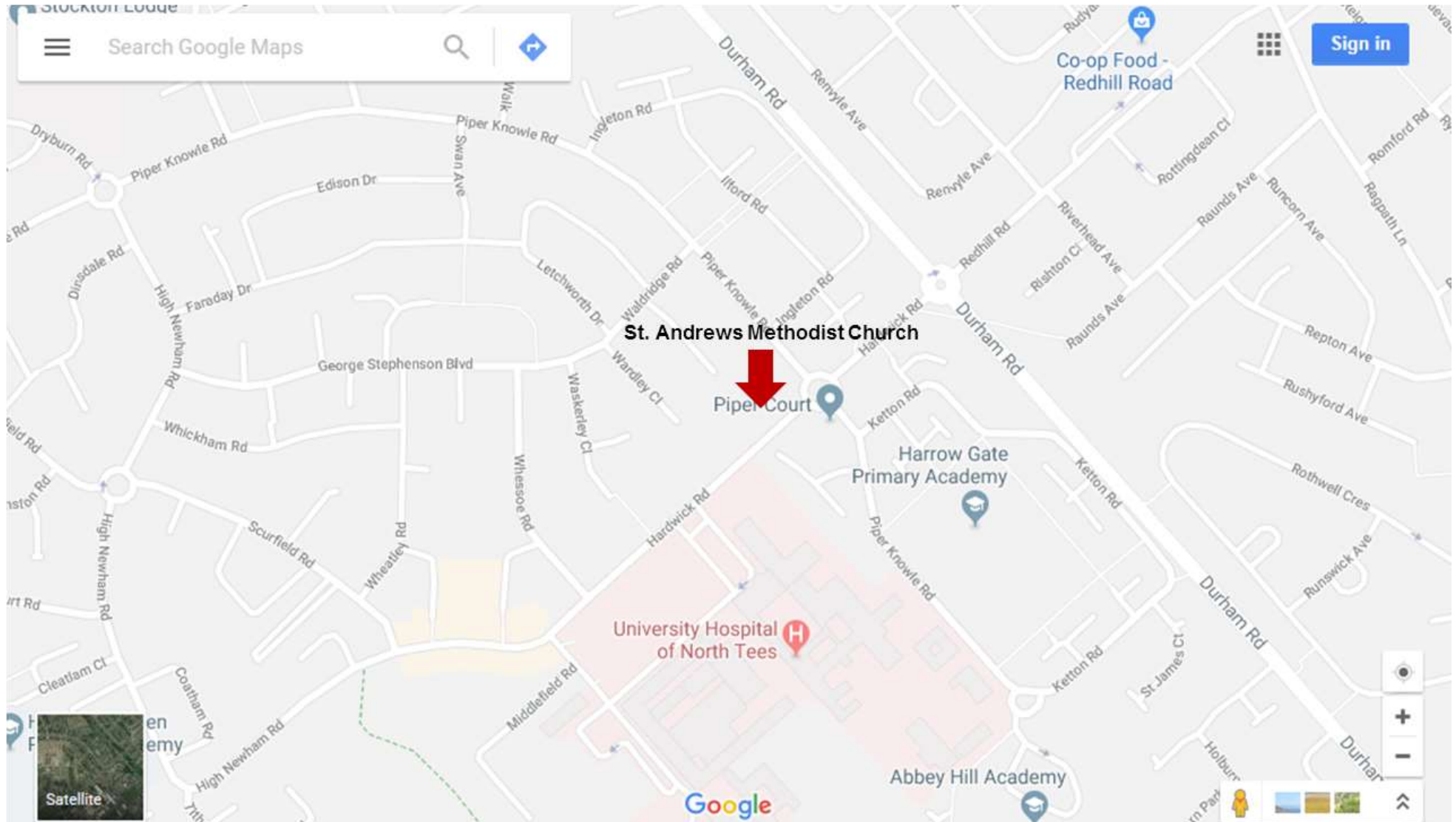
