English	<p>Pupils must continue to work through their English Literature 6-week Revision Plan Booklets. Tasks for half term are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • TUES: Knowledge Organiser Self-Quizzing for 3 poems: <i>'Neutral Tones'</i> and <i>'The Farmer's Bride'</i> in Revision Exercise Book • THURS: Watch Mr Bruff Analysis videos on the two poems above and make notes on key points in revision book. • SAT: Memorise Mr Bruff's Love & Relationships rap (as a way to remember quotes). Listen to x5 times. • SAT: Make flashcards for the two poems. Draw a sketch for each poem to help you remember the key imagery. Use headings such as Meaning, Language, Structure and Theme. Use your annotated anthology and photocopied booklet to help. <p>Extension Work (optional, but recommended):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Read the annotations and the information on <i>'Neutral Tones'</i> in this pack. Complete the Quick Test at the end of the worksheet. • Find the GCSE English Literature – Love & Relationships sheet with <i>'Winter Swans'</i> and <i>'Neutral Tones'</i> (it has two pictures on the page) and test your knowledge on the two poems by completing the planning sheet. You could also try answer the exam question at the bottom, using your plan. • Find the GCSE English Literature – Love & Relationships sheet with <i>'The Farmer's Bride'</i> and <i>'When We Two Parted'</i> (it has two pictures on the page) and test your knowledge on the two poems by completing the planning sheet. Science	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Complete revision work booklets (1 each for biology, chemistry and physics) • Use subject knowledge organisers to help complete booklets
RE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All pupils are to attempt all the 35 day revision activities as set in class over half term and have them fully completed.
Geography	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Revision for Paper 1: The Challenge of Natural Hazards, The Living World and Physical Landscapes of the UK. Exam Style A3 question booklet to be completed to aid revision. Use subject knowledge organisers, revision guide and folders • Revision for Paper 3. Human and Physical Geography fieldwork. Use subject knowledge organisers, revision guide and folders • Complete Coasts past GCSE exam question
History	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Revision for 'Paper 1: Germany 1890-1945' - complete Example 2 and Example 3 of Q2 in interpretations booklet; complete Example 3 of Q3 in interpretations booklet. Use revision guides and books to help with content for answers. • Revision for 'Paper 1: Conflict and Tension' – complete Example 1 and Example 2 questions for Q1 in exam skills booklet; complete Example 2 questions for Q2, Q3 and Q4 in exam skills booklet. Use revision guides and books to help with content for answers
MFL	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Key revision strategies for the holidays to be completed in short bursts of 15-20 mins PER DAY. • Learn your theme 2 roleplays, theme 1 or 3 photocard and your 2 conversation themes (2 and 1 or 3) by heart and time yourself. • Use Kerboodle, your white gcse book and memrise to practise vocab/listening/reading/writing tasks (ensure you can write about holidays and area) for the 3 other papers.
Fine Art	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Personalised HW set based on teacher feedback.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Overall focus needs to be on filling blank areas of sketchbook. • You are to complete a proposal sheet which outlines your plans for the 5 hour timed test. You will be provided with this in lessons. Think carefully about the media available – this could be a large painting or a ceramic outcome.
Photography	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Personalised HW set based on teacher feedback. • Create an investigation page on one or more Photographers mentioned on the exam question. This is in addition to your independent photographer. • If you need to take additional photographs to support your project this is the last opportunity to do this. Contact sheets must be produced for any new photography • You are to complete a proposal sheet which outlines your plans for the 5 hour timed test. You will be provided with this in lessons.
Textiles	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Personalised HW set based on teacher feedback. • To further investigations by recording texture that relates to your texture drawings. Line, shape and tone should be the focus of this recording. Remember this should link to your coursework. • You are to complete a proposal sheet which outlines your plans for the 5 hour timed test. You will be provided with this in lessons.
Three Dimensional Design	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Personalised HW set based on teacher feedback. • To further investigations by recording three dimensional shapes that relate to your architectural/structures drawings. Line, shape and tone should be the focus of this recording. • You are to complete a proposal sheet which outlines your plans for the 5 hour timed test. You will be provided with this in lessons.
Computer Science	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Y11 Computer Science • Work to complete for over half term. • Revision – RAM, Virtual memory, Disability devices • – Conversions of numbers Binary-Denary-Hexadecimal – <i>OneNote notes</i> • – CPU & Secondary Storage devices – re-read and revise <i>OneNote notes & Notes in “GCSE OCR Computer Science Complete Revision and Practice” Book</i>. Complete Networks – all sections – following on from Lunchtime Revision
